
In this exercise, you will watch an video depicting a scenario between a research supervisor and a supervisee. You may choose to watch **either** this scenario **or** one of the other 3 options.



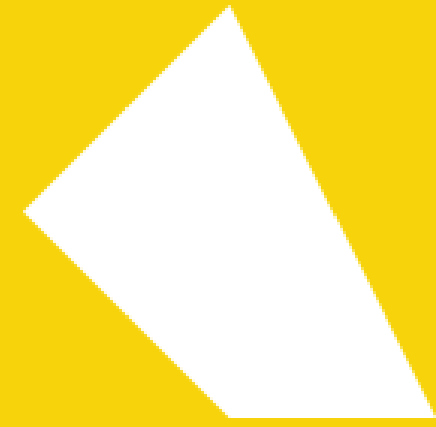
